

Monday/Tuesday: 12th grade


Wednesdays: Online

Bottoms: Pants, no ripped jeans or chains, etc.


Shoes: Closed-toe shoes; no crocs, slides, or sandals

Teacher Hours

Seniors who do not finish credits by May 1st and/or don't participate in the graduation ceremony



REGISTRATION REMINDERS

The Step Up for Students Scholarships (SUFS)

- Applied for during Registration
- Parent / Guardians must remember their account/login information and keep checking their emails to keep track of every information that SUFS sends out
- Approve payment every quarter of the year for student tuition
- Required to attend school in-person 10 days each month

Scholarship Phone Number

- If the phone number changes, it must be updated for the scholarship
- Same consideration if the person who filed the scholarship needs to change

Scholarship Payment Approval

- If payment isn't approved by parent / guardian - student will be locked out of the learning platform until resolved.
- PLEASE log in to the portal if you are unsure of your status and accept payment within the first 5 days of school


