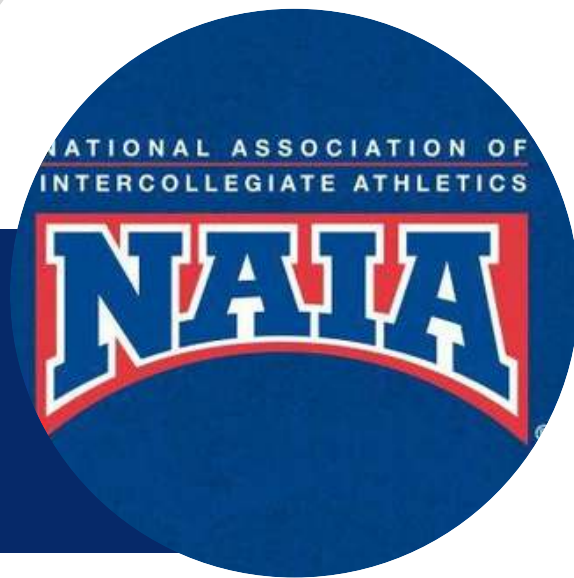

Admissions

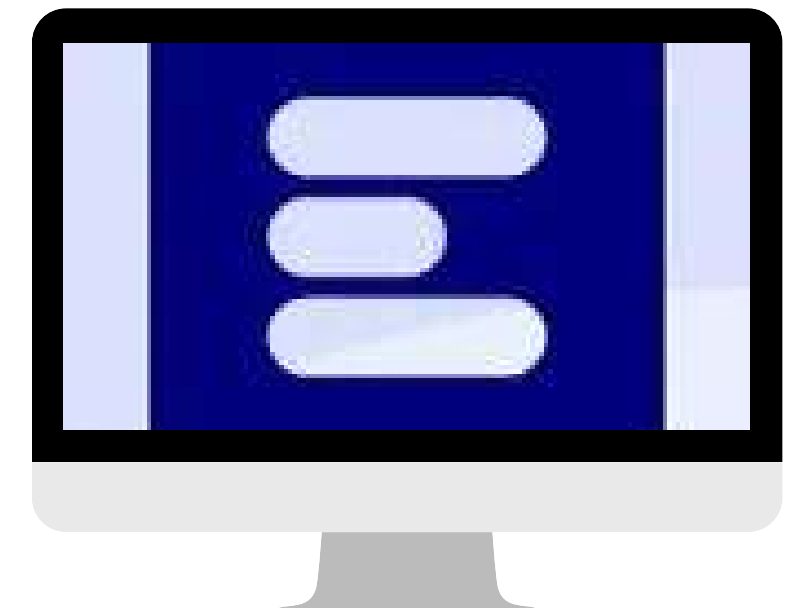

COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS

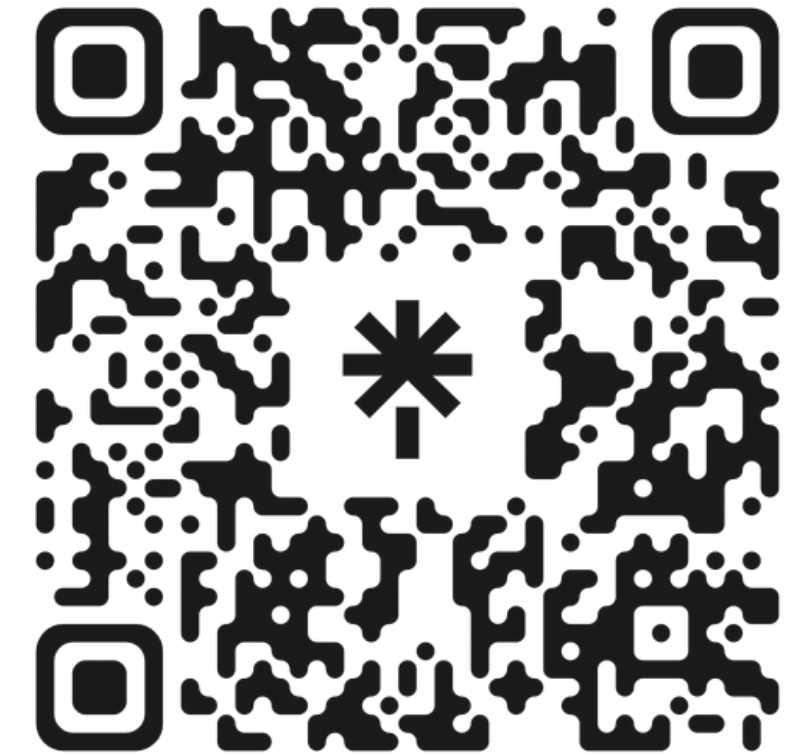
